It was agreed that displays would be arranged for the Town Hall and Berryfield primarily and the following would also be considered:

- Library
- Selwood Housing events
- Fêtes
- Supermarkets (Sainsbury's and Waitrose)

It was agreed that Open Days would be considered for Berryfield and Semington.

Ian emphasised the importance of involving other groups who were obvious potential users of the canal and it was agreed that the following would be specifically invited to participate:

- Canoe Club
- Sustrans
- Walking groups
- Fishermen (Avon Angling Club?)
- Any other groups that come to mind

Chris suggested that Wiltshire Wildlife Trust should have the opportunity to contribute to the consultation process. Bill Jenman will be contacted.

Colin referred to drawings showing suggested detail of the Link route projected on the screen. He emphasised that these were only suggestions to encourage the thought process and explained that they would be circulated to members via email.
